### To Show Time:

after	at once	in the meantime	now
after all of that	before long	in the past (or future)	often
afterward	briefly	last	once
along the way	during all of this	later	promptly
always	earlier	later that same day	sometimes
an hour later	eventually	meanwhile	soon
as soon as	finally	never	while this was
at last	immediately	next	happening

### To Show Place:

above	beside	in front of	opposite
among	beyond	inside	over
around	down	nearby	through
at this point	forward	next to	
behind	from	on	
below	here	on the other side	

### To Add an Idea or Thought:

again	even though	last	otherwise
also	for example	likewise	similarly
and	for one thing	mainly	too
as well as	further	more	
because	furthermore	moreover	
besides	in addition to	next	

### To Illustrate or Explain an Idea:

for example	in particular	such as	to illustrate
for instance	namely	that is	
in other words	specifically	thus	

### To Compare or Contrast Ideas:

but	however	nevertheless	yet
conversely	in contrast	on the contrary	
differently	in spite of	on the other hand	
even so	in the same way	still	

### To Show a Result:

as a result	for that reason	in the end	therefore
consequently	hence	then	thus

### To Emphasize an Idea:

above all	in fact	most important
especially	indeed	

### To Summarize an Idea:

as has been noted	in brief	in short	to sum up
finally	in other words	on the whole
